

## Selling country in the gerund

Two perspectives in one proposition – one is critical, subjective, conceptual; the other active, pragmatic, objective, commercial, utilitarian and opportunist.

Two apparently irreconcilable perspectives, are confronted in an installation with a performative occupation in an exiguous real estate speculation office. The scene where the action takes place is the showcase of Galeria Presença.

In the window glass you can see an unprecedented work, which configuration complicates the visual relation between the street and the gallery's interior.

This work is made of a plastic shutter where one can see the inscription of a telephone number. An inscription that in virtue of the daily practice of street advertising, as it happens in our country, remits to the eventuality of a place for sale or rental.

From the inscription, we may say that it transforms the installation into a device, since it establishes one among other possibilities – the hipothesis of communication between the audience in the street and the artist that remains inside the gallery.

The action of the artist Isaque Pinheiro will be accompanied by other characters/agents in the performative action: a curator/critic and a lawyer, multiplying the performative possibilities and creation of other narratives.

In this fiction, these characters, taking into account the role they often possess and play, are charged with other suspicions. The first can amplify the poetic and conceptual charge; the second immediately implies a technical awareness about the juridical contingencies that take place in the art market and the boundaries that can be placed around the artistic praxis.
