Maria Trabulo's multi-disciplinary practice examines the role that images and artifacts play in shaping both personal and collective historical narratives and the influence of politics in cultural narratives throughout history.

Biography

Maria Trabulo (b. 1989, in Porto)

is a visual artist and researcher based in Porto (PT). She has exhibited extensively, and since 2012, has participated in artist residencies in Austria, Germany, Iran, Italy, France, Greece, Portugal, and Spain.

Education

From 2007 to 2012, Maria Trabulo received a BA Degree in Fine Arts (Painting), at the Faculty of Fine Arts, University of Porto, in Porto, Portugal. She also holds an MFA from The University of Applied Arts Vienna (AUT) and is currently a Ph.D. Candidate at the School of the Arts – Universidade Católica in Porto, Portugal.

Awards and Scholarships

In 2022, she was awarded the *Sovereign Portuguese Art Prize*, by the Sovereign Art Foundation. In the same year, she was also the winner of the *Young Artists Award*, given by the EDP Foundation & MAAT Museum, in Lisbon.

In 2021, she was part of a PhD Research Fellowship, at the Fundação para a Ciência e Tecnologia, in Portugal.

In 2018, she was the winner of the *Novo Banco Revelação Prize 2018*, awarded by the Contemporary Art Museum of Serralves, in Porto.

In 2015, she won the *Ignaz Semmelweis Art Prize*, awarded by the Balassi Institut in Vienna.

In 2014, Trabulo was given a *Specialization and Professional Valorization in Arts* Scholarship from the Calouste Gulbenkian Foundation in Lisbon.

In 2011, she was awarded the Faculty of Fine Arts Grand Prize (which is awarded to the best finalist project of the Degree in Fine Arts) at the Faculty of Fine Arts in the University of Porto, Portugal.
